Doveland International Schools Abuja was established by Engr. (Dr.) Johnny and Chief (Dr.) Mrs. Justina Ulunma Chukwu, who serves as the school's Executive Director. Operations began on September 9, 2009, at its initial location on No. 21 Lingu Crescent, near the NNPC Filling Station on Aminu Kano Crescent in Wuse 2, Abuja. The school began modestly, enrolling three pupils in kindergarten 1, Grade 2, and Grade 4, supported by a dedicated team of eleven staff members.

The school was officially registered as a limited company with the Corporate Affairs Commission on June 6, 2006, under registration number RC665404. On May 12, 2010, the Honourable Minister of the Federal Capital Territory (FCT) granted provisional approval for its site through the Department of Policy and Implementation (DPI). Subsequently, the school was authorized to commence academic activities on May 19, 2010.

In September 2015, Doveland celebrated a significant milestone with the opening of its permanent campus at Plot 150, Doveland Crescent, Apo, Abuja. This new Wumba Campus is designed with spacious classrooms, modern libraries, specialized rooms, well-equipped playgrounds, state-of-the-art science laboratories, ultra-modern dining facilities, and a Special Educational Needs (SEN) unit. We are still growing, with a population of over 1,300 students.





HIGH SCHOOL ONLY IN WUMBA CAMPUS

At Doveland High School, we offer a dynamic British-Nigerian curriculum, designed as a six-year programme divided into two key stages:

- Key Stage 3 (Years 7–9): Key Stage 3 is a three-year foundational phase where students are introduced to a broad spectrum of subjects, including Arts, Humanities, Languages, and Sciences. In Year 9, students sit for both the Cambridge Checkpoint Examination in English, Mathematics, and Science and the Basic Education Certificate Examination (BECE) in line with the Nigerian curriculum.
- **Key Stage 4 (Years 10–12):** Key Stage 4 spans three years, beginning in Year 10, with a strong focus on preparing students for their **IGCSE (British)** and **WASSCE (Nigerian)** examinations in Year 12. Students select a minimum of five and a maximum of eight subjects, leading to the prestigious **International Certificate of Education (ICE)**, awarded by the University of Cambridge Local Examination Syndicate (UCLES).

Our tailored approach ensures that each student follows a personalized timetable, allowing them to sit for both the IGCSE and WASSCE examinations in their chosen subjects while receiving the necessary academic support to excel.

Our high school is built on a distinctive ethos of **excellence, proficiency, and leadership,** which is embedded in every aspect of school life. With the dedicated commitment of our management and the passionate efforts of our staff, we embrace a holistic approach to learning. 
